



After clicking "Plan My Trip," the trip planner tool will populate with a route map along with trip options and fares.







An app with real-time arrival info for our stops in the Puget Sound region.

How to read the app:

- Green = means the bus is on time
- Blue = means the bus is late
- Red = means the bus is early
- Black = means the real-time info is available (shows if the bus is delayed or ahead of schedule)

The OneBusAway.org website or app provides real-time bus arrival times. Now you know if your bus is running late, is on time or going to arrive early. The app uses your phone's GPS location to pull up the buses serving your location.


Bike Parking
